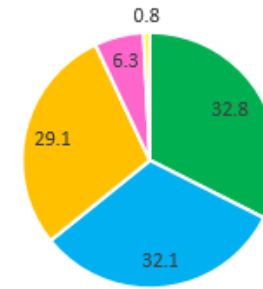

PERFORMANCE INDEX

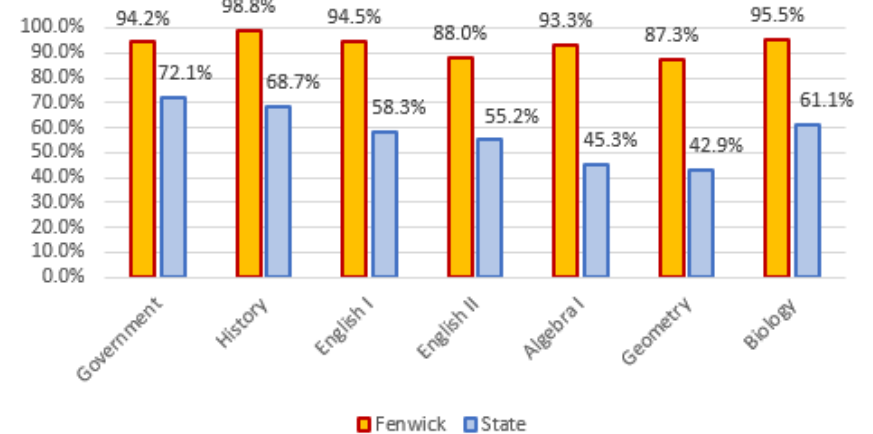
The Performance Index measures the test results of every student, not just those who score proficient or higher. There are five levels on the index and schools receive points for every student in each of these levels. The higher the achievement level, the more the points awarded in the school's index. This rewards schools for improving the performance of all students, regardless of achievement level.

% In Each Area

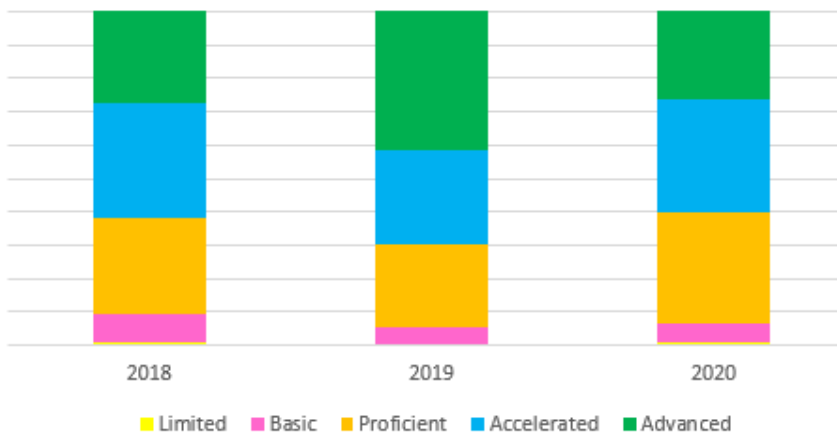

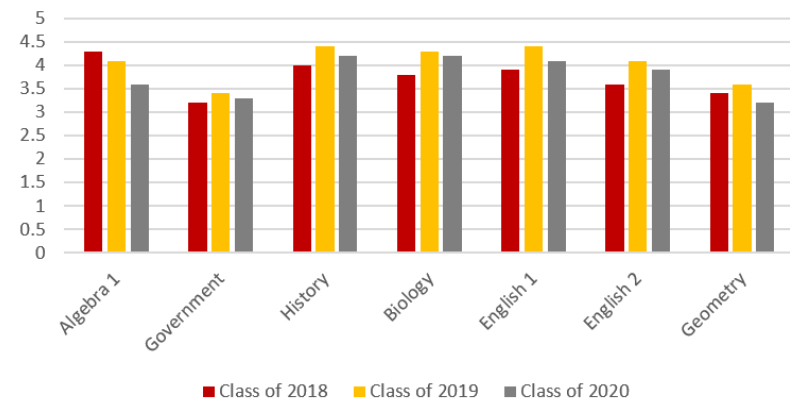
% Students Earning Proficient Or Higher 2016-17

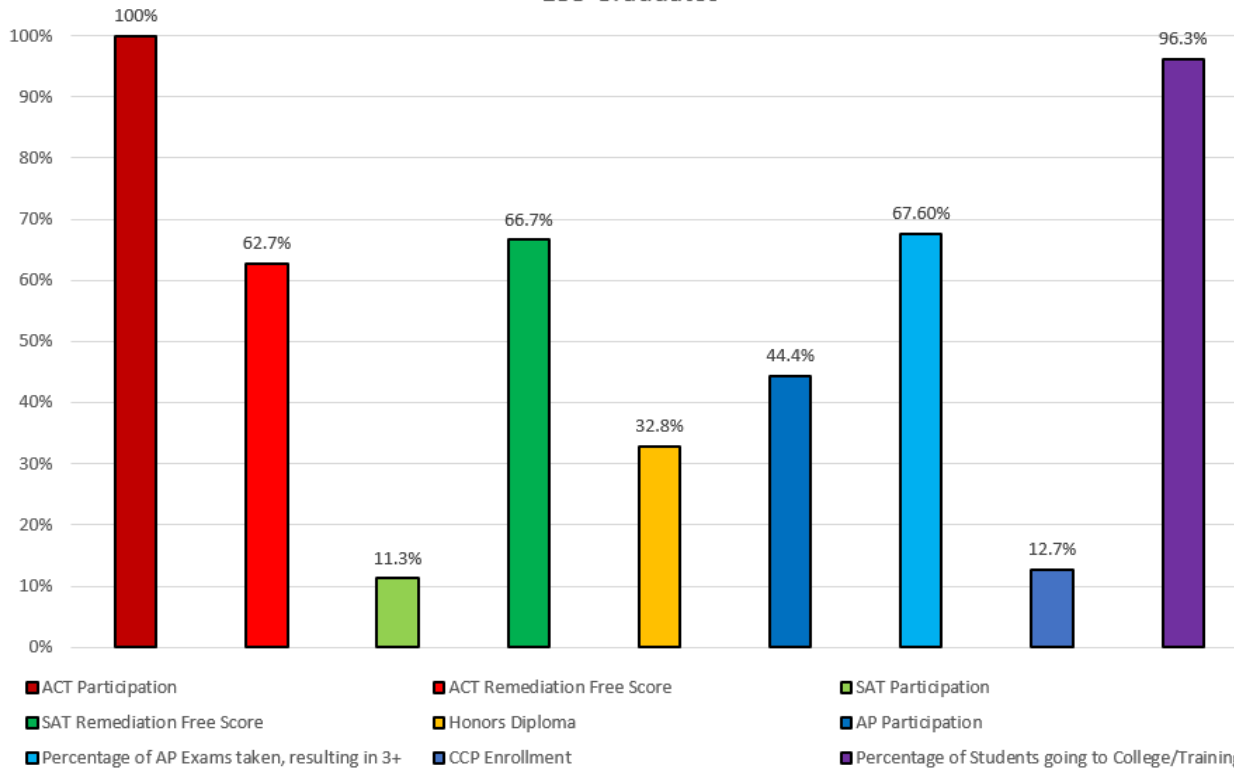
