- Three body paragraphs that analyze the novel along with MLA formatted quotes
- MLA format

Note to students: Focus on the following details while reading the novel-

- 1. Why is this novel a parable? What is a parable?
- 2. Who is the main character and what does he learn about leading and coaching?
- 3. Who is the mentor/Christ figure in the novel? What does he teach the main character about leading?
- 4. What is the overall concept of Servant Leadership proposed in this novel?
